**CLAUSE 1

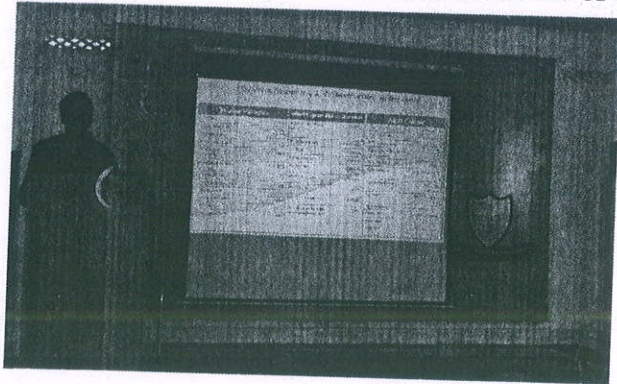
