6. In the interaction with the Experts and the representatives of the Adikavi Nannaya University, the following suggestions and recommendations are noted and the concerned departments are requested to follow the same.
 - i. Dr.P Chiranjeevini Kumari, Member representative Governing Body, Educationist: She suggested that the comparative analysis towards the improvement of attendance, class performance of the students and the Percentage of pass is to be obtained.
 - ii. Sri Ayyagari Venkatesh, Senior Advocate and Alumni: The department of political science is advised to arrange talks by advocates on day to day laws and code of citizen's behaviour.
 - iii. Dr. T Satyanarayana, Professor & Principal, PG Courses: The suggestion is given to conduct Bridge course for I year students and the opinions regarding the syllabus and examination pattern to be elicited from the students. He also suggested that skill based training and communication skills to be given to the students.
 - iv. Dr. Suresh Varma; Professor & Dean IT, ANUR: suggested that common board for minimum marks in all departments, flexibility to conduct internal examinations for absentees with a special

resolution. Social activities like NSS, NCC, ODF campaign and sports of one semester may be given 2 credits from next academic year onwards with a specific resolution in concerned Board of studies. A book may be written with collective material of new cluster system and published by the faculty members of concerned departments. The members of faculty may be sent to industries for training and do NPTEL online courses in Google. Students also encouraged to do the same.

v. Dr. T. Hymavathi, Principal, University college of Science and Technology: IITs of Chennai, Kharagpore, and others offer online courses for short term training, and faculty are encouraged to do the courses. Publication papers by the faculty to be encouraged.


