1. Resolved to approve the syllabus for the I, II, III, IV, V & VI Semesters (Theory & Practicals) as appended herewith.
2. Resolved to follow the following pattern for Examinations
 - a) Each Year is divided in to two semesters (I & II for I Year, III & IV for II Year, V & VI for III year. In VI semester one out of three elective paper (VIIA, VIIB, VIIC) will be selected as per the choice of the student, one set of cluster out of three sets (VIIIA-1, A-2, A-3, VIIB-1, B-2, B-3 and VIIC-1, C-2, C-3) will be selected as per the choice of the student for III Year
 - b) Paper of I, II, III & IV Semester of 100 marks each has 30 marks of internal evaluation and 70 marks of External evaluation. The Internal evaluation (30 marks) is distributed as follows: Attendance-5 marks, Assignments-10 marks, Internal examination-15 marks. The paper of V, VI semester of 100 marks each has 25% internal evaluation and 75% for external evaluation
 - c) During each semester 2 Internal Examinations for each paper will be conducted as per schedule. Introduction of Multiple Choice Questions and Online pattern partially in internal examinations.
 - d) Average of the two internal Examinations will be considered. Absentee will be awarded zero marks.
 - e) The minimum pass marks for I, II & III years for external Examination is 35%. Candidate should get a total of 40 marks in internal and external examinations put together.

f) The pattern of semester examinations and practical – I, II, III, IV, V & VI is here with appended.

g) Practical examinations will be conducted at each Semester end.

4. Resolved to approve the panel of paper setters and examiners as appended herewith.
