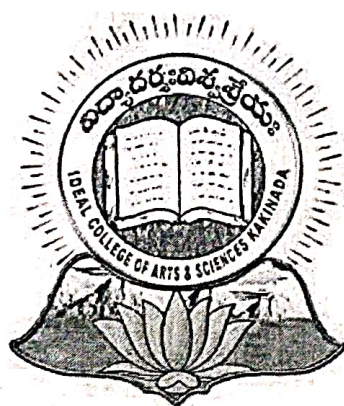

Resolutions:

The members present discussed the syllabus relating to all semesters including Practical in Zoology and proposed the following resolutions

Resolution 1: Resolved to adopt revised Adikavi Nannaya University Syllabus drawn as per UG Course structure CBCS pattern w.e.f. 2020-2021 admitted batch.

Resolution 2: Resolved to start IV year B.Sc. Honours Zoology Course for candidates who complete III year's degree successfully from the year 2023-2024 in Ideal College of Arts and Sciences (A), Kakinada.

Resolution 3: Resolved to approve the minor subjects of Botany / Chemistry / Computers etc... students can option any minor of their interest.

Resolution 4 : Resolved to approve the scheme of examinations for the Eight semesters and practical of I B.Sc., II B.Sc., III B. Sc., & IV B.Sc. Honours Zoology as detailed below:

1. The syllabus of each paper is divided in to two semesters (I & II for I Year and III & IV for II Year, V for V semester and one out of three elective paper (VIA, VIIA, VIB, VIIB, VIC, VIIC, VID, VIID) will be selected as per the choice of the student, one set of cluster out of three sets (VIA, VIIA, VIB, VIIB, VIC, VIIC, VID, VIID) will be selected as per the choice of the student for III Year.
2. Resolved to approve of the 6 courses in semesters VII & VIII, 5 courses (3+2) are subject related and one course shall mandatorily be open online course in any discipline, encouraging trans disciplinary to VII semester three out of six electives papers (8A, 8B, 8C, 8D, 8E & 8F) to choose one pair from the four alternate pairs of skill enhancement courses (9A, 9B, 10A, 10B, 11A, 11B, 12A, 12B) will be selected as per the choice of the student.
3. VIII semester three out of six electives papers (14A, 14B, 14C, 14D, 14E & 14F) to choose one pair from the four alternate pairs of skill enhancement courses (15A, 15B, 16A, 16B, 17A, 17B, 18A, 18B) will be selected as per the choice of the student.
4. V, VII & VIII Semester paper of 100 marks each has 30 marks of internal evaluation and 70 marks of External evaluation. The Internal evaluation (30 marks) is distributed as follows: Attendance-5 marks, Assignments-10 marks, Internal examination-15 marks
5. I, II, III & IV Semesters paper of 100 marks each has 40 marks of internal evaluation & 60 marks of External evaluation. The Internal evaluation (40M) is distributed as follows: Attendance-5 marks, Assignments & Project Works -15 marks, Internal examination - 20 marks

6. During each semester 2 Internal Examinations for each paper will be conducted as per schedule. Introduction of Multiple Choice Questions and Online pattern partially in internal examinations.
7. The minimum pass marks for external exam are 35%. Candidate should get a total of 40 marks in internal and external examinations put together for I, II, III, IV, V, VII & VIII. Average of the two internal examinations will be considered. Absentee will be awarded zero marks. No minimum pass mark for internal assessment.
8. Practical Examination will be conducted at the end of each Semester for 50 marks.

Resolution 5: Resolved to approve the model question papers of I, II, III, IV, V, VII & VIII semesters and Practical examination of I B.Sc., II B.Sc., III B.Sc., & IV B.Sc. Honours Zoology as appended.
