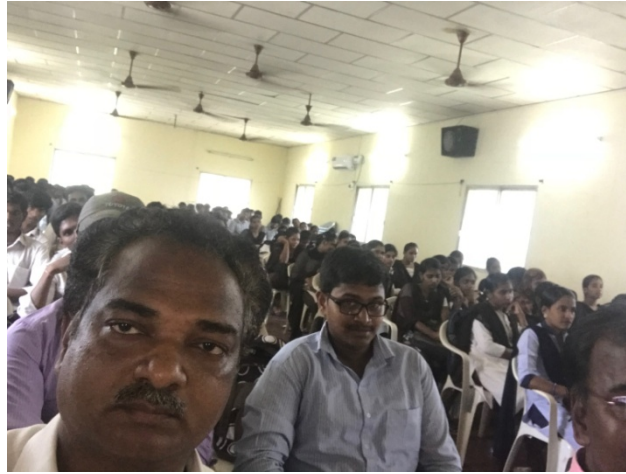
Second Session
