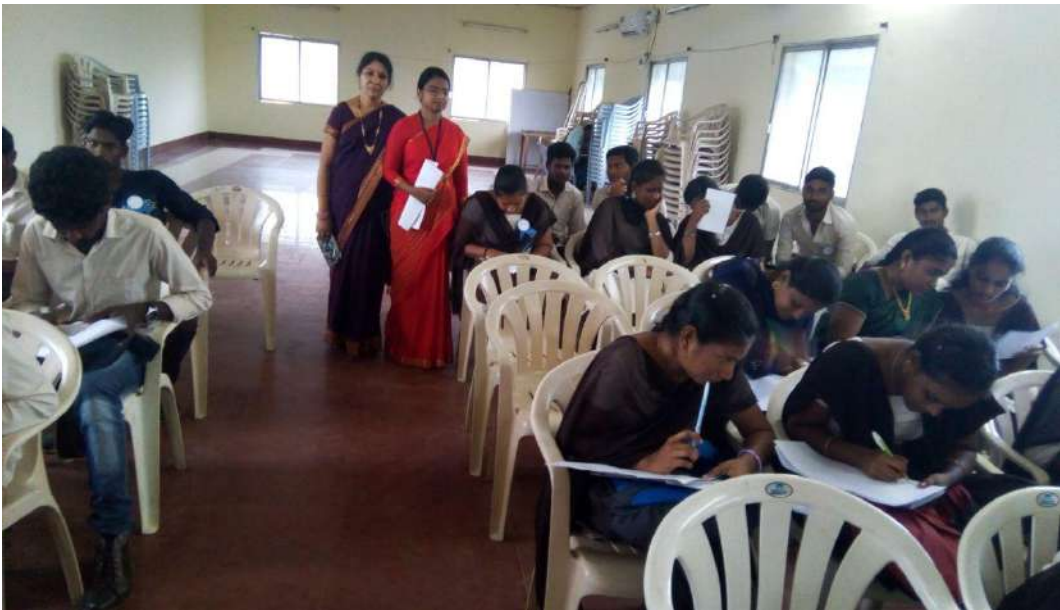
Third session:
